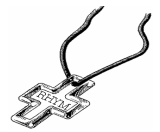

RHYM CODE OF CONDUCT AND EXPECTATIONS

Since the purpose of RHYM is to gather for faith, fun and fellowship in a safe, Catholic- Christian atmosphere, the following code of conduct and expectations has been adopted:

All participants are expected to:

- 1) Respect and honor others, property, and self at all times.
- 2) Not possess or use any illegal drugs or medications not listed on their health form.
This includes over the counter medications (like Advil), cigarettes and alcohol.
- 3) Demonstrate modesty in dress, language, and action. (Short shorts, short shirts, tank tops and shirts with inappropriate messages should not be worn to meetings and events)
- 4) Follow the directions of adult and peer volunteers.
- 5) Clean up after themselves.
- 6) Sign in at the start of each meeting or event.
- 7) Tell an adult if they are leaving the main area where the meeting or event is taking place.
- 8) Respect check-in times during special activities and trips.
- 9) Respect that the Youth Minister has the final say on the application of these expectations without argument or exception.
